1987




1. 3rd Armoured Division would like to extend a very warm welcome to all competitors and guests to the 1987 BAOR Orienteering Championships.

2. HACKENER MARK has been associated with Orienteering for over 20 years, it was the venue for the first German national championships in 1963 and was again used for the German team relays in 1981.

3. Terrain. The area is fairly physical especially with recent brashing having taken place in the eastern half. All courses will cross several deep valleys.

4. Map. 1:15000, 5m contour interval re-surveyed and extended Mar 87. Since then several new extraction tracks has appeared. These have not be shown. Rootstock has not been mapped.

5. 10F Symbol. All courses will use 10F description. The only BOF Symbol used is  for platforms.
