## FOOD POISONING DUE TO CONTAMINATED WATER BOWSER

- Could the following be publicised down G3 Trg channels.
- At the Army Orienteering Championships at Longmoor in May 90 there was an outbreak of illness characterised by explosive vomiting and diarrhoea.
- Investigation of the incident implicated squash provided at the finish. The squash was prepared from water from a water bowser filled from a clean source using a dirty hose (normally used for cleaning a swill area).
- The following points should be noted:
  - The council of perfection is that any water in a water bowser should be sterilized even when drawn from a clean source.
  - As a minimum, if such water is not sterilized:
    - (1) The water bowser should have been cleaned using calcium hypochlorite (water duty men are taught the procedure).
    - (2) If a hose is used it should similarly be cleaned, and not likely to be a hazard due to its previous use.
