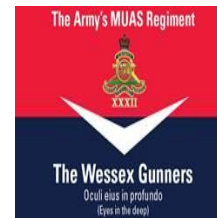

Terrain:	Mainly open plain on a 70m high ridge running SW to NE with some flat open fields in the North and West, some small areas of open Beech woodland and numerous areas of juniper bushes and blackthorn thickets. A good network of tracks throughout.				
Mapping:	Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour for most courses with 1:7500 for Sh Green. 5m contours, Full re-map in 2024 with further updates for this event. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control descriptions for all courses on the map and loose in the start lanes.
