Travel Directions:	Altcar Training Camp via the main entrance (w3w basket.candles.campfires).				
Terrain:	A mixture of grassed sand dunes, open firing ranges, wooded areas and military buildings. The River Alt flows through the area, only crossable by the marked bridges.				
Mapping:	Scale 1:7500. 2.5m contours. New survey and map for the event. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control descriptions for all courses on the map and loose in the start lanes.
